Make your way to Dromkeen, which is located on the Melbourne side of Riddell's Creek. Enjoy a delicious Devonshire Tea/Coffee or cake on arrival.

Take a short tour of this National Trust home before browsing through the galleries, including the world-famous Picture Book Art Collection and impressive militaria display.

The cost for morning tea and tour is \$20 per head.



Heading north, we pass through Romsey and Lancefield to the volcanic plains which link the hamlets of Pyalong and Tooborac.

The winding road takes us through this eerily beautiful area with granite boulders of all shapes and sizes strewn on the hills flanking the road.

Drivers will need to keep their eyes on the road and not on the boulders as there are no safe spots to pull over.



This 26-span, railway bridge was built in 1889 to service the Bendigo line. It was closed in 1968 and is now fenced off to preserve it.

You couldn't get a better back drop for your photo of your classic car than at the largely intact trestle bridge located just outside of Pyalong.

We will stop here briefly before continuing on to our lunch stop at nearby Tooborac Hotel. Lunch is at your own cost.



Our lunch venue is the oldest listed National Trust country Pub in Victoria. With ample parking and onsite Brewery and Bakery it is a popular destination for car clubs.

Once the word gets out that you are going to this iconic pub you may well be flooded with requests to bring home one of their famous pies directly from the bakery. So, bring along your esky as well as your good cheer for a traditional pub lunch with your fellow Bristol Enthusiasts.
